#### **The challenge –** to deliver all-out digital transformation

From the very beginning, The Bar Council had a vision to break down data silos, eliminate all inefficiencies and step up the services they offer to their members. Ultimately, they were striving for that evasive "single source of truth"

#### **The solution -** *MyBar integrated platform*

The implementation of an integrated CRM and web solution to create the MyBar members portal. With MyBar, barristers can self-serve and manage their membership.

## **And finally...** *the* **smart***entry app*

We suggested and prototyped the very first mobile app to support the "<u>Professional Access Scheme"</u> to securely hold each Barrister's ID. This could be verified by an electronic reader at court security gates so security staff could fast-track them into court, meaning barristers had direct entrance to courts without queuing to be searched.

With ever-increasing security checks and searches, the pilot app reduced these long queues, streamlined the process and got the barristers to court much more quickly.

The **smart***entry* app received extremely positive feedback from members and saved 511 hours of barristers' time just within the pilot – it's easy to imagine the value of that time.

This outstanding return on investment moved the pilot to full deployment into hundreds of courts – a great achievement for all.
